

TITLE: Official Associated Students of Boise State University Resolution Opposing Senate Bill Number 1254

WHEREAS, The Idaho Legislature is considering Senate Bill Number 1254, that would permit guns on campus and limit the State Board of Education's and Idaho's public universities' and colleges' authority to regulate weapons; and,

WHEREAS, ASBSU executive team, along with student assembly support, unanimously agree to oppose this bill; and,

WHEREAS, The student assembly is composed of various student leaders on campus who have been appointed to represent the student body; and,

WHEREAS, Members of the ASBSU executive team addressed the active student assembly and discussed the bill thoroughly; then therefore,

WE AS THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF BOISE STATE UNIVERSITY, HEREBY RESOLVE that the Idaho Legislature take into heavy consideration the aforementioned student body opposition to Senate Bill Number 1254, and;

THEN LET IT BE EVEN FURTHER RESOLVED that the Associated Students of Boise State University urge Idaho Legislators to recognize the far-reaching impact this has on our student body. Students have expressed that they prefer dealing with campus weapon policies at the university level and place our trust in our university administrators. Students feel that Boise State University has provided a safe student learning environment; moreover, students have the utmost confidence in our campus security and local law enforcement officers. The right to determine campus weapon policies should rest with each university's governing body.
